Boston native, BW Gonzalez is an actress who plays the dynamic Mrs. Muller in Center REP's current production of *Doubt*. As the mother of the boy at the center of the controversy, audiences are surprised and intrigued by the unusual and complex responses of Mrs. Muller. Gonzalez affirms, "Having doubts and being skeptical should not be perceived as weakness in individuals but instead, as a strength."

With over 30 years of theatre experience and a BFA in performance from Boston University, the actor has played a wide variety of roles. From TV sitcom characters to Titania in *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, and Lady Macbeth in *Macbeth* to Ariel in *The Tempest*, she finds every role as an actor interesting. "Getting work as an actor is always exciting," explains Gonzalez.

Some may recognize Gonzalez from her role as Lupe on the Emmy award-winning show, *Arrested Development*. When speaking of her experience in Walnut Creek she reveals, "I would love to come back and work for Center Repertory Theatre. The audiences are warm, savvy, generous and highly intelligent."

The award-winning actor has worked across the country (as well as internationally) and has created acting and drama workshops for primary, secondary and tertiary education systems as well as at-risk youth, juveniles, men and women in prison and physically disabled children and young adults.

"I knew from the time I could speak that I wanted to pursue acting," states Gonzalez. When asked what her proudest moment as an actor is, she says, "Performing on the same stage as a professional that I performed with as a student at Boston University and then, receiving a Citation of Excellence for my work in my home town and the Massachusetts House of Representatives."
